

Key to NEP Syrrhoe from shelf and slope depths (modified from Barnard 1972)

1. Cephalon extended as a forehead, dorsal and anterior margins of head less than perpendicular.....2
Cephalon with anterodistal margin curved hemispherically, dorsal and anterior margins of head nearly perpendicular.....4
2. Coxa 1 strongly broadened, distal margin twice as broad as proximal.....**S. oluta**
Coxa 1 not distally broadened, anterior & posterior margins subparallel.....3
3. Antenna 1 articles 2&3 lacking distal teeth.....**S. longifrons**
Antenna 1 articles 2&3 bearing distal teeth.....**S. sp A**
4. Telson cleft $\frac{1}{2}$ its length; epimeron 3 with smooth subquadrate shoulder above posterior ventral serrations; coxa 5 with two slits on posterior margin above a posterodistal notch with imbedded seta.....**S. sp CS1**
Telson cleft $\frac{2}{3}$ its length; epimeron 3 with very short smooth notch between posteriodorsal and posteroventral serrations; coxa 5 with three posterior teeth diminishing in size ventrad.....**S. crenulata**
