Distinguishing Characteristics:

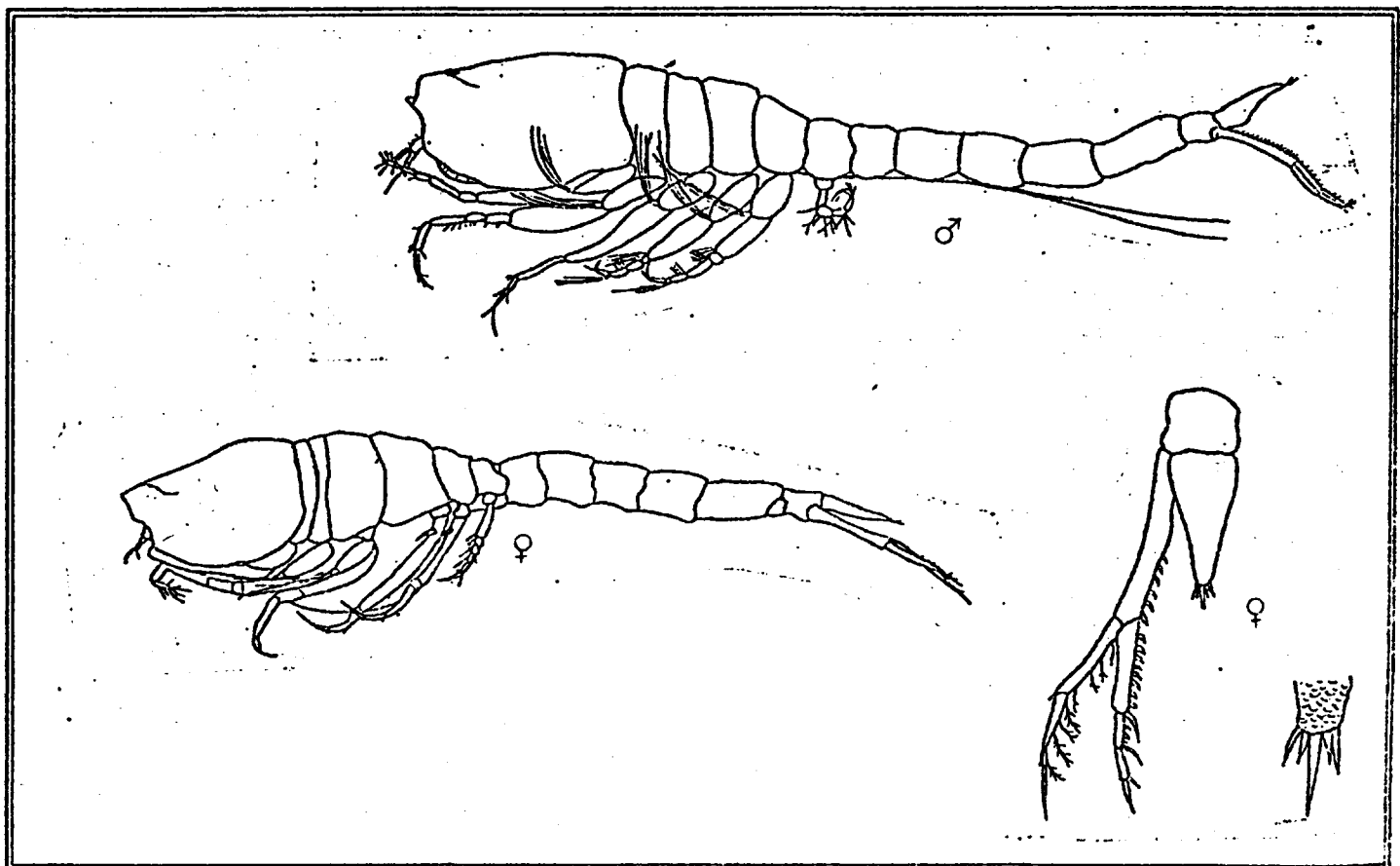
No ridges on carapace (except mid-dorsal)

Pseudorostral lobes acutely produced, projecting well beyond the almost
obsolete anterolateral corner

5 apical spines on telson, no laterals

Peduncle of uropod is over twice as long as sixth segment with spines on
the inner margin

Exopod shorter than endopod and bearing long plumulose setae
