

Distinguishing Characteristics:

- Pseudorostrum somewhat produced anteriorly
- Subrostral notch very poorly defined
- A narrow distinct groove or furrow runs backward and upward for about half the length of the carapace from the pseudorostral margin
- Carapace smooth



