

Amphipholis pugetana (Lyman, 1860)

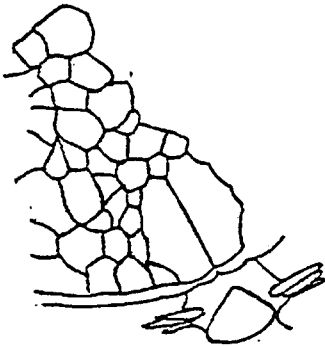


FIG. 1. Aboral surface of disk (McClendon, 1909)

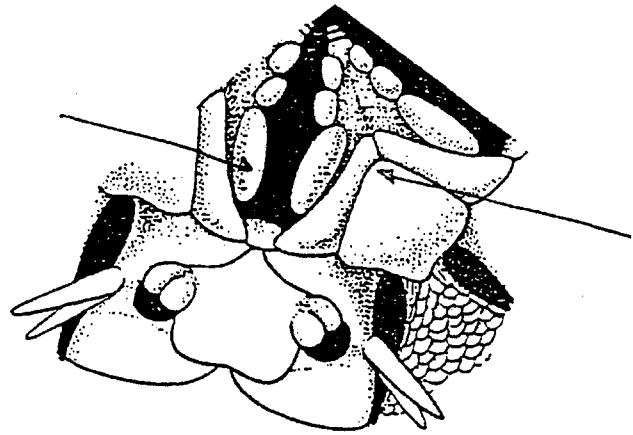


FIG. 2. Oral side of disk (Boolootian and Leighton, 1966)

Keys out fairly easily in Boolootian and Leighton (1966):

Radial shields about twice as long as wide and meet along their entire length as in Fig. 1. Six oral papillae per jaw; distal pair broad and elongate, two proximal pairs small (Fig. 2).

\*Median Arm spine noticeably longer than lateral spines. Blunt and thick.
