Diagnostic Characters:

Live: size 25 mm-50 cm length; 2-5 mm diameter. Mouth and proboscis pore separate and without cephalic grooves and caudal cirrus. Body white, head rounded with posterior often coiled in a spiral. Anterior behind head often appears wrinkled in preserved specimens (Fig. 1). Lateral nerve cords are imbedded in the longitudinal muscles in the anterior and posterior regions (Fig. 2).

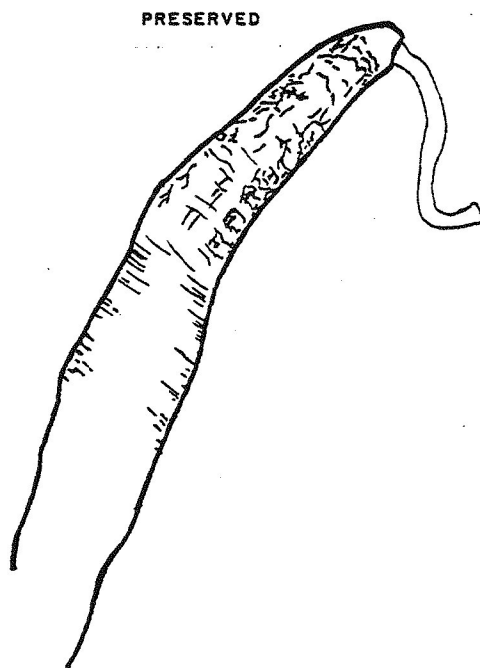

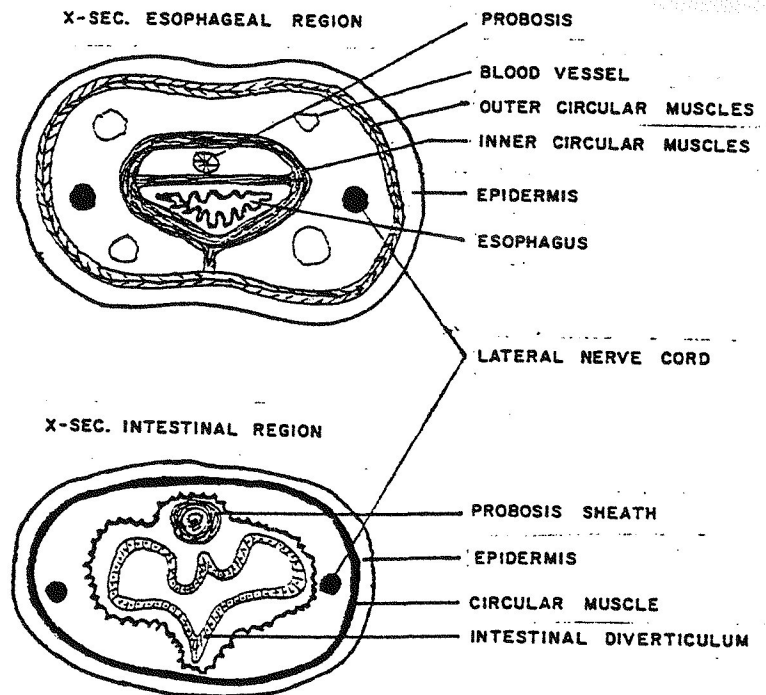
