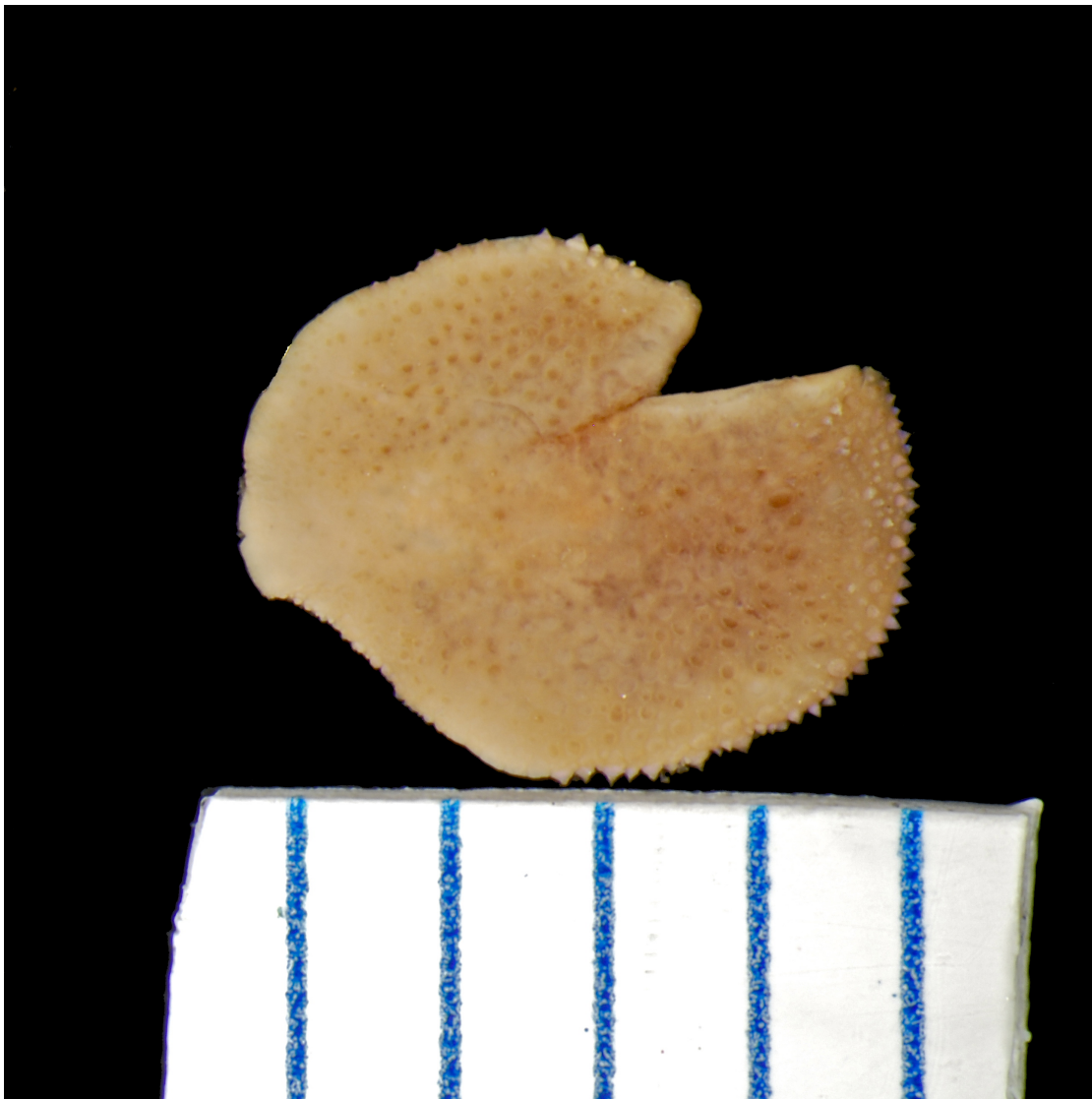


Figure 1. Preserved specimen of Enantiidae sp A SCAMIT 2013 collected from Platform Edith off Huntington Beach.

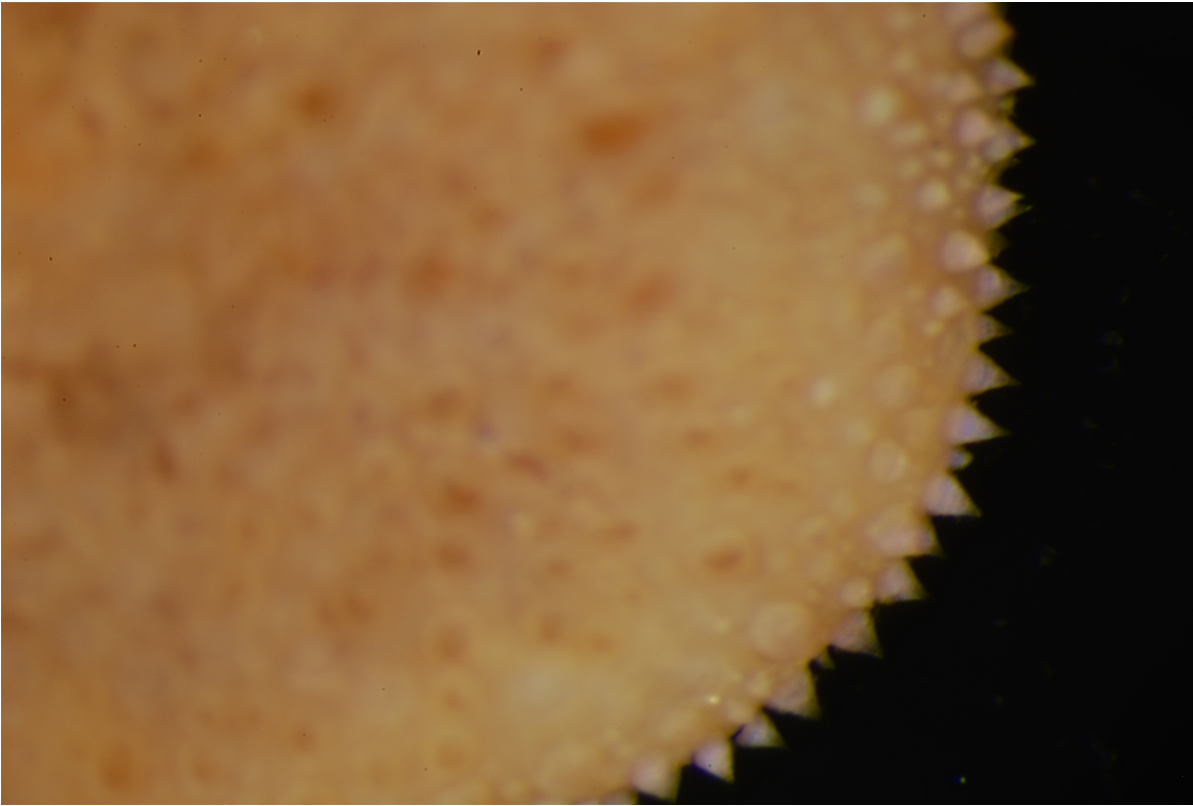


Figure 2. Close-up of marginal pointed spines that encircle body of *Spinantia* sp A SCAMIT 2013.

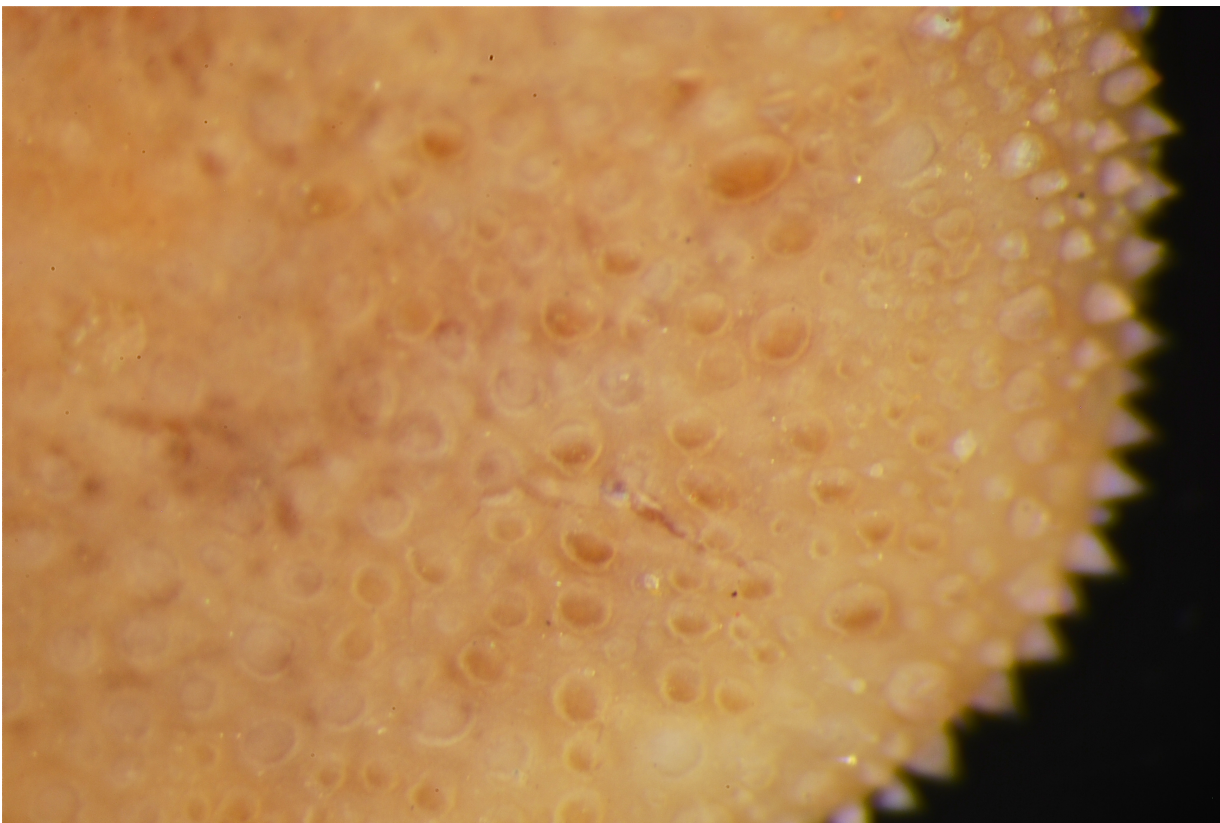


Figure 3. Close-up of papillated dorsum of *Enantiidae* sp A SCAMIT 2013.

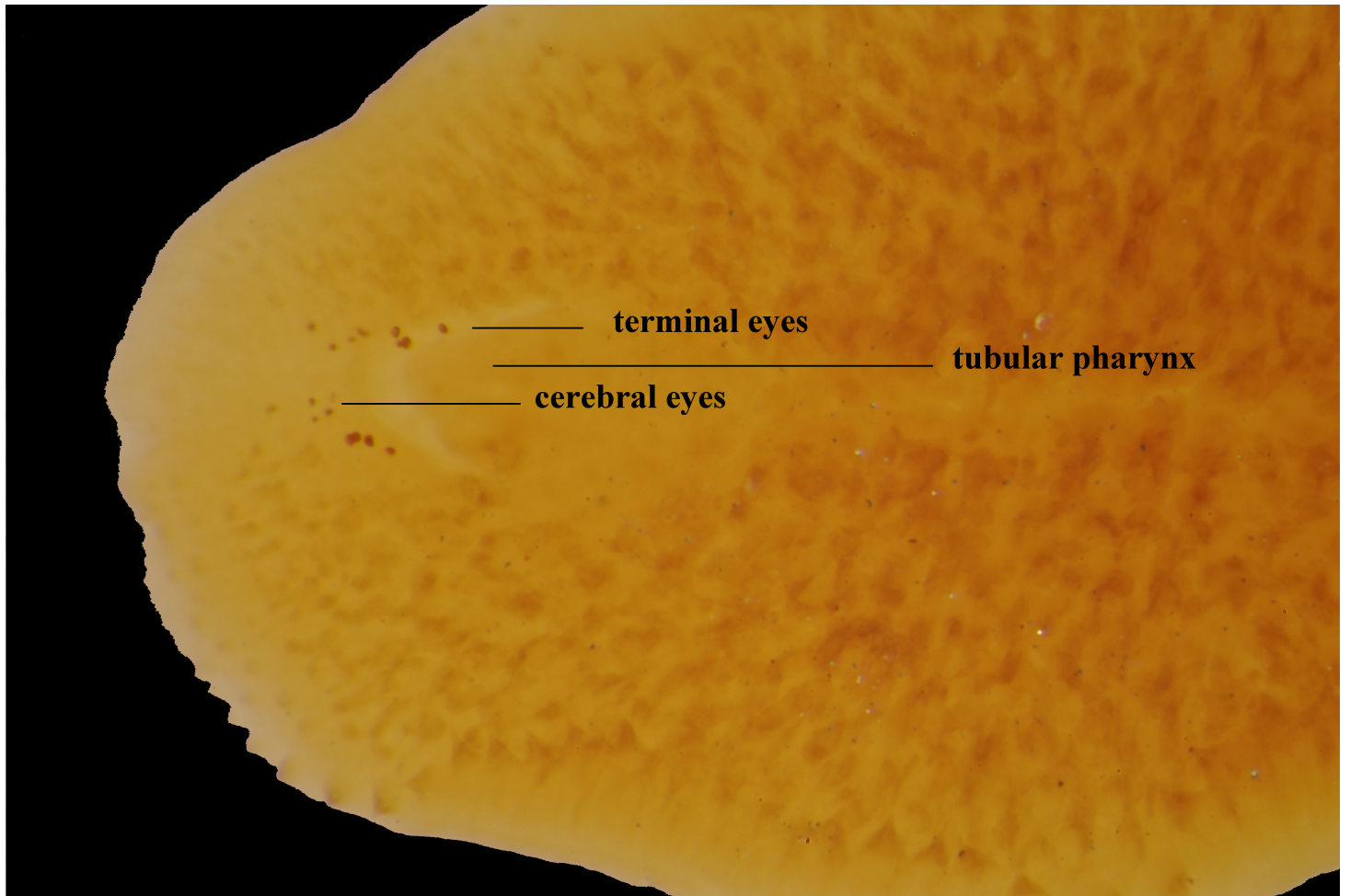


Figure 4. Close-up of eye pattern of Enantiidae sp A SCAMIT 2013
