

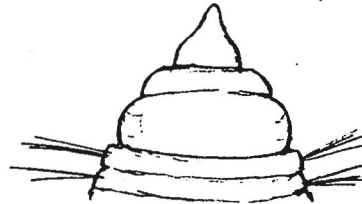

Characters: (based on single ant. frag. ~100 segments, ~3.5mm max. width)

1. Tentacular filaments from setiger 6
2. Neuropodial spines from setiger 16
3. Notopodial spines from ~setiger 40
4. Maximum # of spines = 4/ramus
5. Spines light, translucent yellow
6. No obvious methyl green stain pattern.
Some scattered speckling on most segments
7. Body white with an iridescent epidermis

This is nearest *Cirriformia tentaculata* (See Fauvel, 1927 pg 91-92). See R. Rowe for more information. This does not fit *C. moorei* or *C. spirabrancha* of Blake, 1996 (MMS).
I have seen several specimens similar to this from western Mexico (?near the border).
