Diagnostic Characters:

Median antenna short multibranched (fig. 1); 13 to 17 pairs of branchiae; abdominal neuropodial modified setae thick distally recurved with terminal arista (sometimes broken) (fig. 2).

Related Species and Character Differences:

Allia ramosa differs from other west coast Allia by the multibranched median antenna.



Strelzov, 1973


