

Argissa hamatipes


Diagnostic Characters:

- Coxae 1-3 decreasing in size
- Coxae 4 the largest
- Four evenly spaced eyes forming a circle
- Last half of the animal robust
- Dactyls short
- G1 and G2 similar and subchelate
- Pereopods 5-7 subequal
- Telson deeply cleft
