Caprella natalensis

Diagnostic Characters:

- Head with median anteriorly pointing process. Pereonites smooth or with small paired dorsal tuberculations, especially posteriorly.
- G1 with serrate grasping margin on propodus and dactylus.
- G2 propodus twice as long as broad
- Distinguished by the combination of rostral spine and long antenna 2.




Figure 5.3. Caprella natalensis (from Laubitz, 1970)
