

Eohaustorius washingtonianus

Diagnostic Characters:

Rostrum moderate to weak
 Coxa 1-4 enlarging, coxa 4 dominate
 Gnathopods feeble and simple
 Pereopod 4 smaller and unlike pereopod 3, reversed in orientation

Peraeopod 7, basis, hind margin proximally with strong cusp or tooth
Pleon plate 3 produced, posteriorly as weak tooth
P4, segment 5, distal lobe base, smooth
P6, segment 4 with at least one other spine cluster above lower row, segment 5 lacking posterior marginal spines, segment 4 subtriangular, widest distally, length <2X width
G1 dactyl, nail longer than body




FIG. 11. *Eohaustorius washingtonianus* (Thorsteinson). Female (5.5 mm). Pt. Roberts, WA.
