

# *Gibberosus myersi*

## Diagnostic Characters:

Body compressed laterally, all urosomites free

Eyes lateral and large

G1 simple, carpus long but not lobate

G2 sexually diverse, enlarged in male, but basically simple

Pereopods 3-4 with bent article 2 so as to emerge from coxal bundle and project above head for walking and perching upside down

Rami of U3 broadly expanded, paddle-shaped

**Ocular lobe of head with sharp angle or cusp**

**Merus of G2 with large distal lobe often produced along or underriding carpus**

**Peduncle of U1 with interramal tooth**

**Spines on P3 and P4 not clavate nor hooded**

**E3 strongly serrate**

**Telson with dorsal and apical spines**




Figure 12. *Gibberosus myersi*, h = male "h", L = female "L".
