
Americhelidium rectipalmum

Diagnostic Characters:

- Coxa 4 regular, posterior angle little produced
- P 6, antero-distal lobe shallowly rounded
- G1, palm of propod perpendicular
- G2, dactyl large, ~1/3 length of propod

Synchelidium rectipalmum

DIAGNOSIS

Characterized by:

1. Palm of gnathopod 1, propodus almost perpendicular to lower margin

Basis of peraeopod 5 rather narrow, posterior margin with long setae.
 Head not strongly vaulted; rostral apex not strongly downturned,

rather blunt; antennal sinus shallow.
4. Outer plate of maxilliped with nine rather long spines.
