

Bathymedon roquedo

Diagnostic Characters:

- Rostrum long, reaching more than half way along article 1 of antenna 1, and exceeding lateral cephalic lobe.
- Rostrum stout, nearly horizontal, anterior surface curving downward forming obtusely acute point
- Eyes present, small, yellowish
