Monoculodes emarginatus

Diagnostic Characters:

- Eyes small, lacated as far back from the apex of the rostrum as its own length
- Telson emarginated (somewhat bifid)
- G1, article 5, lobe does not appear to be pinched at the base
- G1, article 5, lobate
- Pigmented eyes present




Fig. 4. Monoculodes emarginatus n. sp. Female, holotype, 4.5 mm, sta. 2637. A, head; B, mesosome; C, D, antennae 1, 2; E, F, gnathopods 1, 2; G, H, I, J, K, peraeopods 1, 2, 3, 4, 5; L, telson.
