

## *Photis* sp. OC1

### Diagnostic Characters:

#### Male:

G2, palmar tooth large, distally upturned or broadly rounded  
Body often covered with many pigment spots  
Head with distinct pigment patch dorsally along posterior margin  
Antenna 1 without line of pigment in peduncular articles  
G1, article 5, anterior margin weakly setose  
G2, inner margin of dactyl swollen, distinctly narrowed distally; palmar tooth tapered or broadly rounded  
Coxae densely setose  
G1, article 5 subequal to article 6, posterior margin elongate and unproduced, article 6 sinuous, defining corner rounded  
G2, article 6 broad  
P4, articles 4 and 5 normal slender

#### Female:

G2, scarcely oblique, palm nearly vertical, weakly excavate, its margin sinuous, the defining corner acutely produced; palm without palmar tooth or defining tooth  
Body often covered with many pigment spots  
Head with distinct pigment patch dorsally along posterior margin  
Eye normal  
P4, articles 4 and 5 normal slender
