Diagnostic Characters:

Male:

Eye lobe distinctly acute (dorsal and ventral margins concave)

Ventral margin of coxa 1 scalloped

G2, palmar tooth tapered; palm not noticeably long, nor strongly oblique, bearing only one palmar tooth, in addition to the defining tooth

G1 convex, article 5 sub-equal to article 6, posterior margin less than or equal to one-half the length of anterior margin

Eye normal

P4, articles 4 and 5 normal slender

Female:

Eye lobe distinctly acute (dorsal and ventral margins concave)

Ventral margin of coxa 1 scalloped

Eye small and diffuse

Coxa 2-4 normal, not long and strap-like

Coxa 5 not large and triangular

G2 palm convex to nearly flat, without palmar tooth, or defining tooth

P4, articles 4 and 5 normal slender
