Important Characters: Spatulate rostrum and uneven teeth on peraeopod.

Related Species and Character Differences: Looks similar to R. stenades
and R. abronius except the rostrum is broader in R. heterocuspoidatus.

Variability: Teeth on peraeopod 5 and shape of third pleon epimeron will
vary.

Common Synonyms: Paraphoxus heterocuspoidatus
