Important Characters: Very narrow rostrum. Four or five small to medium teeth on peracopod 5.

Related Species and Character Differences: Related to R. abronius but differs by lacking epistomal cusp, and having fewer teeth on peraeopod 5.

Variability: Setation and shape of pleonal epimeron slightly variable.

Teeth on peraeopod 5 also slightly variable.

Common Synonyms: Paraphoxus stenodes. (Barnard. 1960)
