Diagnostic Characters

1. Generally heavily pigmented (orange to red).
2. Carapace with two complete and one partial lateral ridge (see figure).
3. Inner margin of uropodial peduncle with 4 to 6 small spines.

Related Species and Character Differences:

Campylaspis rubromaculata can be confused with C. hartae;
compare the carapace sculpturing pattern carefully.

Distribution: Puget Sound to San Diego; sand, silt bottoms,
kelp hold fast; 6-640 m.




Figure 1. Carapace (from Lie, 1969)





