

***Rocinela angustata***

Class Malacostraca, Subclass Eumalacostraca, Order Isopoda, Family Aegidae

**DIAGNOSTIC CHARACTERS:**

**Frontal margin of cephalon produced, ending truncate**

**Peraeopods somewhat compressed**

**Eyes large but not touching**

Pleonal segments acutely pointed

Posterior margin of cephalon not trisinate


Only four pleonal segments distinct

**4 spines on the propodus of pereopod 1**

\* 5-8 spines on merus of P3

**ILLUSTRATION:**

Legs reddish in color



Eyes large w/clear fossae →

← Spinate Cephalon

looks like a Heron's Vase

← abdominal gills

← pleonal segments free
