CLASS HOLOTHOROIDEA

Subclass Apodacea

Diagnosis. Up to 25 digitate to pinnate tentacles, tube feet absent or highly reduced. (e.g., Caudina, Euapta, Leptosynapta, Molpadia, Synapta, Trochoderma.)

Order Apodida

Diagnosis. Body cylindrical, worm-like, smooth, rough or warty surface, tube feet absent, respiratory trees absent, 10-25 digitate or pinnate tentacles, ossicles include wheels and anchors.


Family Synaptidae


Diagnosis. Tentacles cylindrical or terete, not widened distally, either pinnate or digitate in form. Ossicles as anchors and anchor plates.



General Tentacle Morphology:








Larvae Morphology:
